## RESTRICTED PREMIER

A Restricted Premier dancer is defined as one who has not won an overall trophy in a Premier or Restricted Premier class for two years preceding the date of the Restricted Premier event he/she is entering. An overall trophy is defined as the dancer with the highest total number of points having competed in more than one individual dance in a Premier competition age group. Winners of special events or dances such as a Special Hornpipe or Jig, Best-Dressed or Choreography event DO NOT qualify as an overall trophy win. A Championship and a Pre-Championship is considered a Premier event.

## COMPETITION RULES - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1	Competitors are governed by the rules and regulations of the SOBHD and ScotDance Canada.
2	All competitors MUST present current SOBHD cards. A fee of \$5 applies to those without cards.
3	There will be no refund on entry fees for any reason.
4	Competitors must be suitably attired at all times. <b>Special Note:</b> Suitable change rooms will be provided and clearly marked for dancers. It is asked that all dancers show respect for spectators and guests by refraining from changing costumes in public areas and hallways. Competitors MUST be in costume to receive awards.
5	The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete/cancel classes according to the entries <b>and status changes received.</b>
6	The decision of the Judge is final. With the exception of the Competition Committee communication with the Judges and Pipers during the event is not allowed.
7	Protests must be made in writing, signed and given to the Competition Organizer before the end of the competition with a \$25 fee. The fee is refundable if the protest is sustained.
8	No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the necessary fee in the form of a cheque or money order made payable to the Canmore Highland Games, along with a self-addressed stamped envelope. <b>No late entries will be accepted.</b> Entries must be sent individually unless there is more than one dancer in the family.
9	All entries must be received via Canada Post. Entries postmarked prior to May 26, 2010 will be held for 10 days before processing.
10	Last to enter is the first to dance, to pipers appointed by the Committee. Any exceptions will be at the discretion of the Competition Organizer.
11	Awards for Premier 16 & Over will be as follows: 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$45, 3rd - \$40, 4th - \$35, 5th - \$30, 6th - \$25. Restricted Premier 16 and Over: 1st - \$40, 2nd - \$35, 3rd - \$30, 4th - \$25, 5th - \$20, 6th - \$15. *Specials are not included in the aggregate awards. Special Choreography:
12	No parents will be permitted in the marshalling area, except those of Primary dancers
13	No trophies will be awarded in the Primary classes. Primary dancers must choose either Primary A or Primary B.

## **CHOREOGRAPHY RULES**

1. Choreography must adhere to SOBHD choreography guidelines.
2. Choreography must be Scottish or Celtic in appearance and theme including movements and costume.
3. All Choreography entries must be performed to the music 'Gordon McLeod of Winnipeg' as provided by the Canmore Highland Games no other arrangements of this tune will be accepted.
4. Entrances and exits must be within the music provided for the event.
5. The size of the raised platform when the event is held outdoors is 16 feet by 80 feet. If the weather is inclement and the dance events are moved to an indoor location the event will be held in a gym and the available space size may exceed that of the outdoor platform. Dancers are expected to adhere to the outdoor platform size if the event is held indoors.
6. Each entry may have a maximum of 3 dancers. All dancers must hold a current SOBHD registration card. Dancers are allowed to enter the event once, one dancer cannot participate in more than one entry for the event.
7. The event is open to Premier and Restricted Premier dancers.
8. There will be 3 placing for this event. Prize money for each placing in this event is  
1st place \$100.00 2nd place \$75.00 3rd place \$50.00
9. A maximum of 10 entries will be accepted.
10. The winners of the event will be announced at the dance competition and awards presented at the Closing Ceremonies.
