Results for solo events will be posted at the Piping & Drumming Tent. Medals and adjudication sheets may be picked up at the registration table at the completion of each event. Professional prizes will be awarded after the morning events. Band prizes will be awarded at the Massed Band

TRAVEL ASSISTANCE

Travel assistance is available to the first 5 bands registered and paid by July 23, 2009 based on the following formula: **More than 300 km one-way - \$200.00, More than 500 km one-way - \$300.00**

GENERAL RULES – SOLO EVENTS

1. The Competition is governed by rules of the Alberta Society of Pipers & Drummer Website: www.aspd.ca.
2. Competitors are responsible for being at the competition platform at the posted time, ready to play, or to notify the Steward if they will be late because they are competing in another event at the posted time.
3. All participants must be members of a provincial/state piping & drumming association.
4. Competitors will compete in reverse order of entry.
5. Competitors, except of those entered in Novice Chanter/Practice Pad, must be attired in Highland Dress.
6. All competitors must have a competitor number to be worn on the FRONT of the kilt.
7. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, to cancel or combine or split any event.
8. Communication with a judge, with respect to any competitor, event or result, may result in the competitor's disqualification. The decision of the judge is final.
9. Grievances must be made in writing, accompanied by a fee of \$50.00, refundable if the protest is sustained. Grievances are to be made within 30 minutes of the time marked on the posted results of the event. A Grievance Committee will be formed for this purpose.
10. Competitors will not necessarily compete in the order in the program if there are no shows.
11. There will be no field entries.
12. Competitors must enter events in the grade assigned to them by the ASPD or other affiliated Society.

GENERAL RULES – BAND EVENTS

1. The Competition is governed by Alberta Society of Pipers & Drummers rules. Website; www.aspd.ca
2. Bands Playing Up will pay the fee for the Grade in which they enter and 50% of the entry fee for the higher Grade. This also applies to Bands playing up for "Comments Only". Should a band place in the higher grade, it

will receive the award for that grade and will forfeit awards that may have been won in the lower grade. In such a situation, all other bands in lower grade would retain their placing. Requests to play up to a higher grade will not be accepted on the day of the games. Pre-registration is required.

3. Participation in Massed Band in appropriate Highland Dress is compulsory for all bands competing. Non-compliance with this rule may result in your band being disqualified from competition.

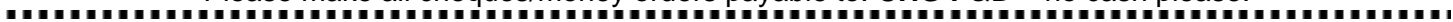
